Your prayers are requested for one of our dear Emeritus Kuzzins – **Martha Boyette**. As many of you know, Martha has been dealing with and being treated for bladder cancer. After three chemotherapy sessions, her doctors decided to discontinue the treatments because they weren't working. On June 29 Martha will have a Cystoscopy, which is a procedure used to see inside your bladder. The doctors will then decide on another course of treatment. Martha needs our prayers right now to get through this time.

Some of you will remember **Syd McConnell** who took main-stream dance lessons with the KK. Syd is also a member of First Christian Church, Garland. Syd McConnell, was admitted Sunday to Baylor Garland. The doctors are telling Syd that she had a stroke Sunday while she was at her home. She was able to call her daughter, Shelly Allen, who called an ambulance. The stroke has severely impeded her vision. From Baylor she will be going to Baylor Rehab in Mesquite for rehab.
