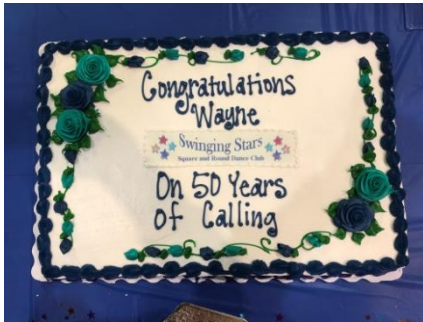

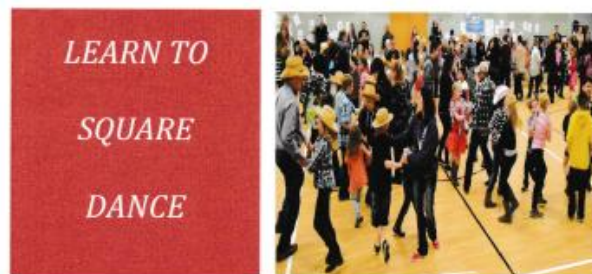
## It's That Time of Year
