Come Join the Fun! Beginning Jive Lessons - Starts Saturday, June 16th.

Linda and JL will be offering Beginning JIVE classes starting June 16. Jive is a really fun rhythm and is very similar to what you might call swing or jitterbug. This class starts from the very beginning of Jive as if you have had no instruction in the Jive rhythm. Even if you have never taken a round dance class before, you can start with this rhythm. In fact, JL and Linda encourage your first lessons to be a Latin rhythm that doesn't required a "closed" frame. Those rhythms include Jive, Rumba, Cha Cha, and Bolero. So, here's your chance to get started round dancing.

The class is from 11:15 am to 1:15 pm on Saturdays through the summer and will be held at Carpenter Recreation Center in the multi-purpose room. 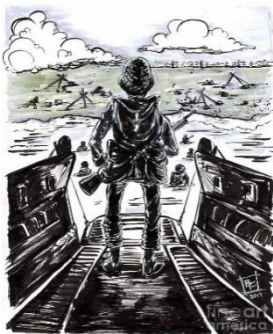
KUZZINS ON THE GO



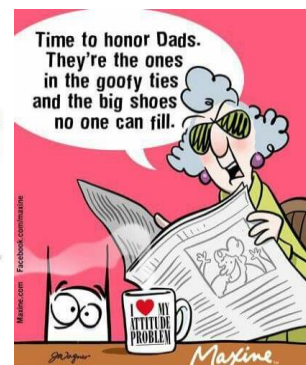
- ❖ Chris and Kimberly Brow are spending the summer and beyond at their cabin in Red River, NM. We'll see them in September when the weather is cooler.
