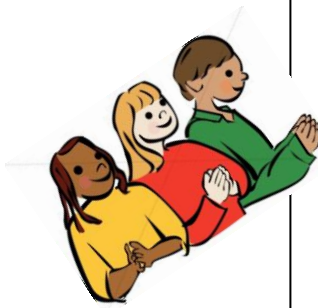

DID YOU KNOW?

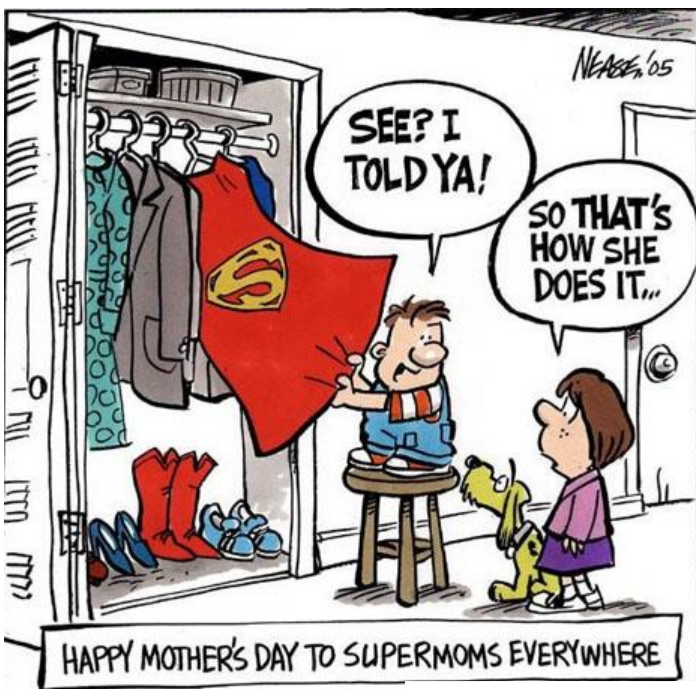
1. **ARMED FORCES DAY** is the day we celebrate (and thank) those who are currently serving in the military.
